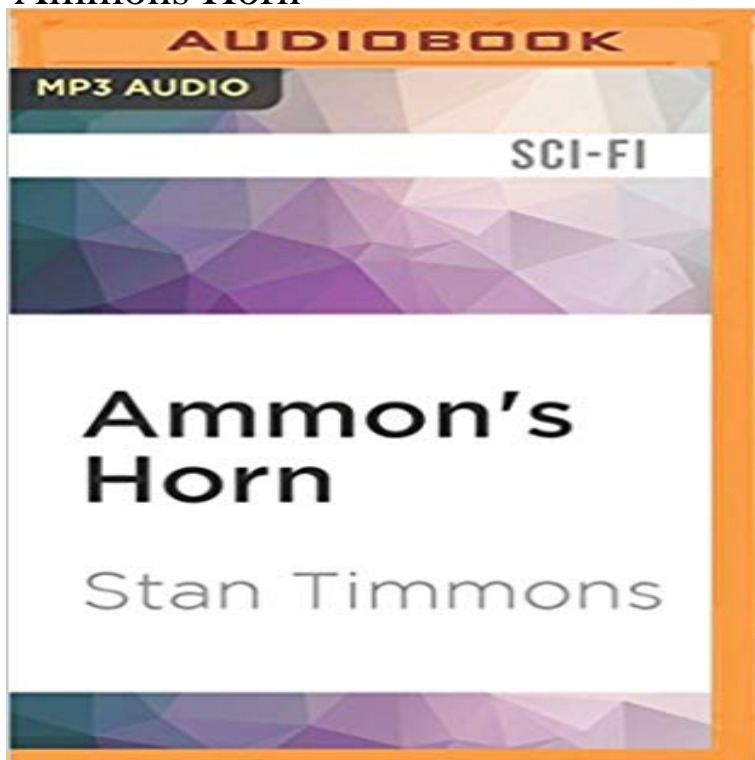


## Ammons Horn
